Important information for Parents and Campers:

CAMP HOURS: Our camp hours are from 9am until 2pm, with pick-up until 2:15pm. Before or after camp care is not available. Please be considerate to our staff and pick up no later than 2:15pm. Parents who are late will incur a \$10 fee per each 15 minutes late beyond 2:15pm.

DAILY DROP-OFF: Daily check-in is at 8:55am at The Dragonfly Art Studio, 1511 Colley Ave, Norfolk, Virginia, located directly adjacent to The Naro Theater. **Please understand that doors do not open until 8:55am, as our staff is busy preparing for camp.**

WHAT TO WEAR: Children should wear comfortable clothing and shoes that can get dirty. They should also bring a sweater or sweatshirt.

WHAT TO BRING: Please send your child to camp with a prepared lunch and bottled water each day, labeled with their name.
